Counted once: Border designs:

- Interrupted
- Patterns, symbols
- Pictorial, including integrated
- Two or more borders

Counted each different one:

- Border material (only if different from base material)
- Border shape
- Border type
- DF
- Working methods

2 pts.

- An animal (Sect. 17)
- An object (Sect. 18)
- A plant (Sect. 19)
- An other pictorial (Sect. 20)
- Contour
- Each different base material, including sub classes

2 or 3 – pts. judges choice

Rarity

- Judges will reference NBB March 2015 pages 16 through 25
- This sheet is to be used as a guideline in assembling your tray. The judges themselves have final say on what button attributes are given or not given points, and how many points each attribute earns.

1 pt. (* each different one)

- Backmark (labeled)
- *Backtype, labeled (sew-through need not be labeled)
- Diminutive
- Imit. sew-thru
- Mechanical / movable
- * OME (only count if OME is in the central part of the button AND is different from the border OME (border material))
- Pattern
- Pierced
- Uniform Div. II
- Usage (glove, livery, work clothes, etc.)
- Verbal (letter, word, number, symbol)
